BINDING old leather-backed boards.

THE LIBRETTO of a pastoral entertainment with musical accompaniment staged in the Palazzo Ducale in Venice. During Marino Grimani's tenure as Doge (26 April 1595–25 December 1605), four such performances were presented each year, customarily on the feasts of Saint Mark, the Assumption, Saint Vitus, and Saint Stephen. The present performance was staged during Ascension Day celebrations.
